We were about 90 miles from the Canadian border when it was time to turn south toward Louisiana. I had one more engagement to complete my consulting contract for a non-profit firm. Driving through Montana that night before checking into a motel I had a most unusual spiritual encounter. It was the revelation of a great Native American chief who had been betrayed by our government. I had no idea who this person was or what significance he was to my journey, but the next day I would be led to a national park service center to hear his story. The next morning, I was still very much preoccupied by that visitation. Before leaving that area, I expressed desire to visit a Native American battlefield, and the famous Little Bighorn site of Custer's Last Stand was not far. However, I did not feel led to go there but somehow was drawn to another site I had never heard of. I believe I spotted it on a map that would not be that far off our return route.

Our destination was Wisdom, MT, a very cowboy-oriented area dotted with ranches and such. Just west of Wisdom was the Big Hole National Battlefield (U.S. National Park Service). As we turned into and parked just in front of the Center. Before I was out the driver's side door a park ranger came out the entrance and yelled to us: "If you want to see a documentary on the battle we are about to start." I thought, "Yeah, I want to know what this is all about."

It was much more than I anticipated as I watched and heard the story how U.S. government troops relentlessly pursued this peaceful band of Nez Perce Indians nearly 1200 miles from their encampment in Oregon to this location. What was their crime? They only wanted to be free to escape to Canada rather than be confined to a reservation that by now generally proved to be uninhabitable. They refused to sign a treaty requiring them to do so, which split their tribe between those who signed and those who refused.

The latter group would follow Chief Joseph and other leaders on the lengthy escape route to Canada. Their mistake? Exhausted from the grueling challenge of staying on the run while carrying their families and whatever possessions they had, some of the leaders agreed there was need to stop and rest believing they were well ahead of their pursuers; all except Chief Joseph. He was outnumbered or "out voted," and they camped to rest which proved a fatal calculation. In the predawn hours of the next morning, they were suddenly awakened to gunfire and canon fire. Though Nez Perce warriors fought bravely

they also had to get their families to safety while holding off the calvary. At the end of the day, they lost around 90 members of their tribe, mostly women and children. Eventually they surrendered to bury and mourn their dead, plus they were exhausted and lacking sustainable resources. The commanding officer, John Gibbons, agreed to Chief Joseph's request to be able to return to their home in Oregon. That, too, would be one more broken agreement (betrayal) on the part of our government. Chief Joseph was never allowed to return home but exiled to Oklahoma where countless Native Americans died in an inhospitable environment with little but broken promises for hope.

So how does this story contribute to my own journey? It is what occurred moments later when we drove from the park center to the scene of the battle on the adjacent property. I felt a deep sense of grief as I walked that area and played my Native American flute, feeling an eerie sense of a haunting presence still seeking reconciliation. We eventually left and drove out of the park area in the opposite direction, taking a circular route back to the interstate. As we ascended a very steep pass my van began to lose power and I pulled over to determine the problem. When I got out of the van and looked back in the direction we had just come from, I was looking down into a steep valley. Then I heard these words: "This valley will be flooded with water." Once again, I reacted in resistance; but this time the explanation that followed would open my eyes causing me to understand what Spirit had been patiently bringing me to see.
