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PROPHETIC INDICATIONS

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Coming Changes and the Shape of Things to Come

"Draw near to God and He will draw near to you." Have you ever questioned the meaning of this verse since God is omnipresent, formless, beyond space and time? Being eternal He is eternally present in and to all His creation. Yet I think of the story in Exodus 3 when Moses was pasturing his father-in-law's flock in the wilderness and came upon a burning bush that was not consumed:

⁴ When the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." (NASB)

It was when Moses "drew near" to see for himself that the Angel of the Lord responded to him. Could he have ignored this amazing sight and missed what would be his destiny to lead Israel to freedom? What happens when we turn and focus our attention on the divine presence within? As written in Psalm 46:10, "Be STILL and KNOW that I AM GOD;" there is a waiting PRESENCE ready to reveal both our true identity and divine calling as Sons of God. In the Gospel of John Jesus made it clear that,

- the Father is IN the Son and
- the Son can do nothing of his own initiative.

Rather the Son is the dwelling place of the Father, and He manifests His Presence, Power and Purpose through the Son. This is the function of the Body of Christ, to manifest the Son of God whose will is to make the Father manifest to the world.

- When we *get still* and *go within*, we open the door of our heart to draw near.
- When we "walk in the LIGHT as He is in the LIGHT, we have COMMUNION one with another (1 John 1:9)."

We are presently living in a world, and particularly a nation, where internal violence and animosity is rising from the heart of humanity to reveal the spirit of *iniquity* or *lawlessness* that is bent on destruction, distortion, and deceit. Yet these things must run their course until mankind is willing to show MERCY and COMPASSION toward each other. I am adding a word previously shared but so relevant to this moment. May we in this Thanksgiving Season offer thankfulness and gratitude in place of judgment and conflict. In closing I share an important verse of admonition from the Apostle Paul:

²³ Now may the God of PEACE Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Thess. 5:23, NASB 1995)

- to attempt to uproot its violence.

- But let your heart be aware of such animosity and not get caught up in it.
- Let your heart find a place of stillness, rest, and peace and safety, that you not get caught up in the storm of violence."
